The result is an art cocoon where the client can host and display their collections, when in Paris.

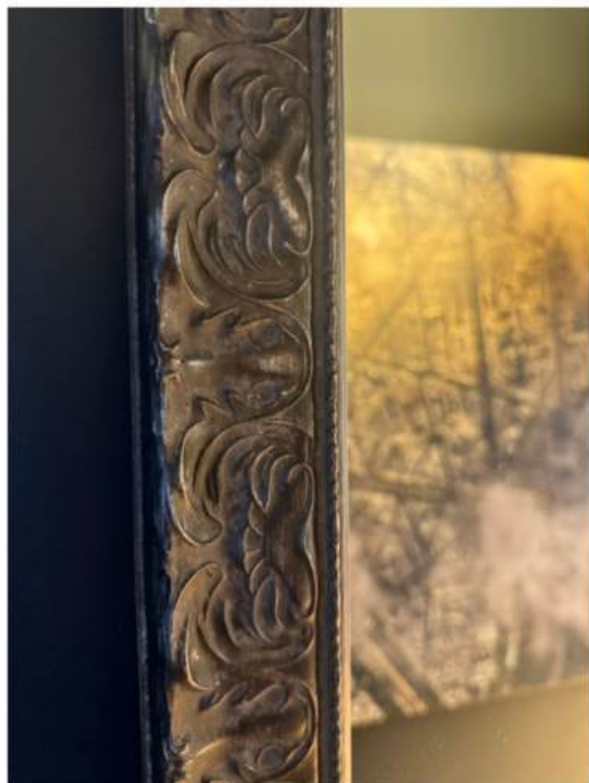
